

Scriptural Confession

Personal Declaration

I openly confess that Jesus Christ is my Lord.¹ Through his death, burial and resurrection, I'm free from the law of sin and death, and by his wounds I have been healed.²

I'm a child of God, a citizen of his kingdom, and an alien to this world system.³ His kingdom and righteousness are my top priorities.⁴ I don't love this corrupt and decaying world or anything in it.⁵ Because I'm dead to the world,⁶ its basic principles no longer control me and I'll keep myself from being polluted by it.⁷ God made me Christ's ambassador and a minister of the new covenant, and committed his message of reconciliation to me.⁸ Therefore, I am the light of this world.⁹

The Holy Spirit lives in me and I have faith in Jesus, so I will do what he did.¹⁰ I'll spread the gospel, make disciples of Jesus, and teach them to obey everything he commanded. In his name, I'll drive out demons and heal the sick.¹¹ I have authority to overcome all the power of the enemy and nothing will harm me.¹² In the power of the Holy Spirit, I'll continue Jesus' task of destroying the enemy's work.¹³

I'm a servant of God, the Lord Jesus Christ, and all God's people as to the Lord.¹⁴ I'll do what the Bible says and the good works God prepared for me to do.¹⁵ I'll use the spiritual gifts he gave me for the benefit of others.¹⁶

I'm an heir of God with Christ and I will share in Christ's sufferings that I may also share in his glory.¹⁷ I'll not conform any longer to this world's pattern and standards, but transform myself by renewing my mind. I'll offer my body as a living sacrifice in spiritual worship.¹⁸

I'll think about that which is true, excellent, and praiseworthy.¹⁹ I'll say only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs.²⁰ I'll conduct myself in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ and set an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, and in purity.²¹ I'll fight the good fight, finish the race, and keep the faith.²² I'll stand firm and do the Lord's work with all my heart.²³

God works everything together for my good, preparing an eternal glory for me according to his will, so I choose not to be anxious about anything.²⁴ Instead, I choose to be thankful in all circumstances and allow God to use them to make me more like Jesus.²⁵

The Lord himself will come down from heaven and catch me up with all other believers to meet him in the air. Then I'll be with him forever.²⁶

I'm Blessed by God

God blessed me by placing his Holy Spirit within me as a guarantee of my inheritance.⁸ The Holy Spirit teaches me all things and guides me into all truth.⁹ He gives me abilities I can use to serve others and be effective in life.¹⁰ He helps me develop godly character traits.¹¹ He even intercedes for me when I don't know how to pray.¹²

God blesses me by giving me peace to guard my heart and mind.¹³ He lavishes his grace, wisdom and understanding on me.¹⁴ He gives me every good and perfect gift, and sends his angels to serve me.¹⁵

God blesses me by enabling me to reign in life, crush Satan under my feet, and be more than a conqueror.¹⁶ He works everything together for my good.¹⁷ He's keeping me strong to the end, and blesses me in the heavenly realm with every spiritual blessing.¹⁸

God blesses me by giving me far more than I need to excel in every good work, and making me rich in every way so I can be generous on every occasion.¹⁹ He enables me to thrive in every situation.²⁰

God blesses me by giving me everything I need for life and godliness.²¹ He enables me to share in his divine nature and escape the world's corruption.²² He causes my tests to develop perseverance in me, making me mature and complete, so I'll receive the crown of life.²³ He's purifying me of everything that's not like him.²⁴
